Age-related Macular Degeneration (AMD)

One out of every five people over the age of 65 in the U.S. has AMD, which is the leading cause of blindness in people over the age of 50. It may cause blindness in about 20% of affected people if not managed correctly.

AMD is a treatable disease. **Early and frequent monitoring of patients with AMD can detect the disease even before symptoms appear**, allowing early treatment that will save vision.

How AMD destroys your sight

The eye has a highly sensitive tissue in the macula region — an area in the back of the eye where light is focused and nerve signals transfer images to the brain. This results in a sharp focus in the center of your visual range, known as central vision. AMD progressively destroys the macula slowly robbing you of your central vision.



The two types of AMD

AMD is a two-stage disease:

- **Dry AMD**

AMD begins in its dry form, from which most people with AMD suffer. Dry AMD is a slowly progressing form of AMD that does not generally result in severe loss of vision. Many patients notice nothing and will just add more light for reading. Dry AMD usually starts in just one eye, and occurs later in the second eye.

Because there is no pain and the progression is gradual, many people consider this slight damage of central vision to be just a normal part of aging. But there is nothing normal about dry AMD — particularly if it progresses to the more severe wet AMD.

- **Wet AMD**

About 15 to 20 percent of people with intermediate-stage dry AMD will progress to the wet form of the disease. At this stage, tiny blood vessels underneath the retina grow out of control, which can cause blood and fluid to leak under the retina. The resulting damage can be devastating, leading to rapid, severe and permanent central vision loss — that is, unless it is detected early and treated immediately.

Your doctor now offers AMD testing with **Foresee PHP™**: a simple, quick, FDA cleared, clinically-proven and non-invasive way to detect changes in the central area of your vision that may indicate the onset of wet AMD.

Even more important, **Foresee PHP™** can often reveal wet AMD at an early stage, before the damage causes permanent vision loss.

What to expect in the Foresee PHP™ test

A number of linear dot patterns are displayed on a touch-sensitive screen. You will be asked to indicate on the screen where you see a distortion in the lines. You respond by touching the screen with a plastic pointer that you hold in your hand like a pen, showing where the dots have "moved" out of line. **That's it!**

Using a customized Foresee PHP™ database and detailed printouts from your exam, your doctor can detect the signs of wet AMD within about 15 minutes.

There are a number of safe, proven therapies available for AMD, including medications and laser surgery. If you require therapy, your doctor will discuss the options most suitable to your individual needs.
